<b>CAST IRON SECTIONAL BOILER</b>		
Basic inspection fee for each steam or hot water low pressure cast iron sectional boiler is	24 (6)	\$140.00
Annual inspection fee for each steam or hot water low pressure cast iron sectional boiler varies with the boiler horsepower of the boiler, as follows:	24 (7)

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Basic fee for inspection of an installation of a steel plate low pressure steam boiler or hot water boiler is	24(4)	\$140.00
Annual inspection fee for a steel plate low pressure steam boiler or hot water boiler varies with the boiler horsepower of the boiler, as follows:	24 (5)	
Not exceeding 25 HP	24 (5) (a)	\$115.00
Exceeding 25 HP but not exceeding 50 HP	24 (5) (b)	\$125.00

<b>REFRIGERATION PLANT</b>		
Basic installation inspection fee for each refrigeration plant is	24 (12)	\$400.00
The annual inspection fee for a refrigeration plant varies with the size of the plant, as follows	24 (13)	
Not exceeding 50 tons	24 (13) (a)	\$110.00
Exceeding 50 tons but not exceeding 100 tons	24 (13) (b)	\$150.00
Exceeding 100 tons but not exceeding 500 tons	24 (13) (c)	\$215.00

<b>UNFIRED PRESSURE VESSEL</b>		
Basic fee for inspection of an installation of an unfired pressure vessel, excluding a propane or anhydrous ammonia tank, exceeding 36 inches in diameter is	24 (8)	\$70.00
Biennial inspection fee for an unfired pressure vessel, excluding a propane or anhydrous ammonia tank, varies with the size of the of the pressure vessel, as follows:	24 (9)	
Not exceeding 24 inches in diameter	24 (9) (a)	\$110.00
Exceeding 24 inches in diameter but not exceeding 36 inches in diameter	24 (9) (b)	\$120.00
Exceeding 36 inches in diameter	24 (9) (c)	\$215.00

<b>FEE FOR STAMPING BOILER OR PRESSURE VESSEL</b>		
Fee for stamping a boiler or pressure vessel is	27 (a)	\$70.00

<b>FEE FOR SPECIAL OR ADDITIONAL INSPECTION</b>		
Where a special inspection is requested or an additional inspection is required by reason of material or work previously found by an inspector to be unsatisfactory, the fee under this regulation plus the fee per hour and travelling expenses	28	\$140.00

<b>FEE FOR WEEKEND OR HOLIDAY INSPECTION</b>		
Where an inspection is requested to be made on a Saturday, Sunday or general holiday, the fee for each inspection plus travelling expenses is	29	\$1080.00

<b>PROPANE AND ANHYDROUS AMMONIA TANKS</b>		
The biennial inspection fee for propane or anhydrous ammonia tank that has a capacity of 1,000 gallons or less is	24 (10)	\$150.00
<b>PROPANE AND ANHYDROUS AMMONIA TANKS LARGER TANKS</b>		
The biennial inspection for propane or anhydrous ammonia tank that has a capacity of more than 1,000 gallons is \$150.00 for the first 1,000 gallons and for each additional 1,000 gallons of capacity or portion thereof e.g. (500 gal) = \$15.00	24 (11)	\$150.00 + \$15.00/1000 gallons

<b>FEES FOR DUPLICATE CERTIFICATE</b>		
Where a certificate of an inspection has been lost, destroyed or defaced, a duplicate may be issued on payment of a fee	30 (1)	\$50.00

<b>AUDIT OF QUALITY ASSURANCE PROGRAM</b>		
Where a quality assurance program or quality control program is required by a code or standard referred to in this regulation, the fee for an audit of the program per hour is	23 (5)	\$110.00

<b>AMMONIA OR GAS DISTRIBUTION PLANT</b>		
The fee for a plan and site inspection of an anhydrous ammonia or liquefied petroleum gas distribution plant is	24 (14)	\$215.00

<b>REFINERIES AND CHEMICAL PLANTS</b>		
The fees payable for the inspection of refineries and chemical plants on continuous non-destructive testing programs inspected by audit vary with the size of the plant, as follow	24 (16)	
Not exceeding 100 pressure vessels	24 (16) (a)	\$2,700.00
Exceeding 100 pressure vessels but not exceeding 200 pressure vessels	24 (16) (b)	\$9,455.00
Exceeding 200 pressure vessels but not exceeding 300 pressure vessels	24 (16) (c)	\$16,200.00
Exceeding 300 pressure vessels but not exceeding 400 pressure vessels	24 (16) (d)	\$22,970.00

<b>ADDITIONAL INSPECTION FEE FOR REFINERY OR CHEMICAL PLANT</b>		
Where a refinery or chemical plant referred to in subsection (16) has more than 400 pressure vessels, the inspection fee for the first 400 pressure vessels	24 (17)	\$19,400.00
For each additional 100 pressure vessels or portion thereof	24 (17)	\$6,755.00

<b>NUCLEAR COMPONENT</b>		
The fee for an in-service or non-shop inspection of nuclear component per hour is	24 (18)	\$205.00

<b>GAURDED PLANT</b>		
The fees for the inspection of a plant that is defined or classified as guarded plant under The Power Engineers Act or the regulations under that Act are as follows:	24 (19)	
For the first inspection	24 (19) (a)	NO CHARGE
For the second inspection	24 (19) (b)	\$30.00
For the third inspection	24 (19) (c)	\$140.00

<b>REPAIRS TO BOILERS OR PRESSURE VESSEL</b>		
The fee for the inspection of repairs to a boiler or pressure vessel per hour	24 (21)	\$140.00

<b>INSPECTION OF PIPING</b>		
The fee for inspection of piping per hour, unless the inspection is of a medical gas piping system and is part of a shop inspection under subsection 23(2), in which case the fees prescribed under clause 23(2) (e) or (f) apply	24 (22)	\$140.00

<b>TESTING OF WELDERS</b>		
Subject to subsection (2), the fee payable for	26 (1)	
The testing or annual retesting of a welder	26 (1) (a)	\$100.00
A welding procedure qualification test	26 (1) (b)	\$100.00

<b>HOURLY FEE</b>		
Where, in the opinion of the chief inspector, the fee set out in subsection (1) does not apply, the fee payable per hour is	26 (2)	\$205.00

<b>FOR SEARCH OF ORDERS</b>		
The fee for a search of orders or other documents issued under the Act and this regulation are	31	
Where no order or other document is found	31 (a)	\$110.00
Where an order or other document is found	31 (b)	\$145.00
