## Single Track Enrollments for the Public Fire Paramedic Program

Starting in February 2024, the Manitoba Emergency Services College will pilot the opportunity to enroll in a single track of the Public Fire Paramedic Program. Prospective students will have the opportunity to enroll in either the Fire Rescue or Primary Care Paramedic portion of the Program for the 2024/25 academic year. Starting in May 2024, 12 seats will be available for single track enrollment:

- 5 seats for the fire rescue
- 8 seats available for the Primary Care Paramedic

This transition creates an opportunity for the Manitoba Emergency Services College and municipalities to grow emergency services capacity in Manitoba by offering flexible options for communities.

Please consider options for how your community can support prospective students who may be interested in this new opportunity and please share this information with community members.

Prospective students may be eligible for funding through entities such as Manitoba Student Aid or the Workforce and Industry Programs and Partnerships branch. Funding is granted on case-by-case basis and prospective students should contact their preferred funding service provider for more information.
